- 1. The Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') hereby gives notice of disclosure of four documents pursuant to Rule 103 of the Rules.¹ The documents contain information potentially disclosable under Rule 103, albeit not directly related to the charges in this case. They are disclosed with limited standard redactions.
- 2. The documents all provide further information and detail regarding [REDACTED].² Three of the documents³ were initially sought by the SPO in December 2020. However, due to staff turnover,⁴ were not processed in the SPO's evidence database at the time. In 2022, the SPO made a renewed request for these records, which were then sent anew by the competent authorities. The fourth document was identified following further searches conducted based upon the information received from the competent authorities in June 2022.⁵
- 3. This filing is classified as confidential as it contains confidential information and references confidential evidence. A public redacted version will follow.
