- 1. On 15 December 2023, the Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') submitted for confirmation a strictly confidential and ex parte indictment against Mr Kilaj. In accordance with Article 39 of the Law¹ and Rule 90(1) of the Rules,² the SPO may amend an indictment at any time prior to its confirmation, without leave. In light of recently discovered additional evidence, the SPO hereby notifies the Single Judge of its intention to file an amended indictment in this case. As such, there is no need for further consideration of the previously submitted indictment.
- 2. The SPO notes that this development impacts the timeline of proceedings, and modifies its prior submissions in KSC-BC-2018-01/F006333 accordingly. However, it is assessed that this course of action will ultimately result in more expeditious pre-trial proceedings, in the event the amended indictment is confirmed.
- 3. This filing is submitted as confidential pursuant to Rule 82. Further, given the sensitive nature of the information contained herein and the potential serious impact its premature disclosure would have on its ongoing investigation, the filing cannot be made public at this time.
