1. Pursuant to the Oral Order¹ and following receipt of the relevant official transcripts, the Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') sent *inter partes* the proposed lesser redacted transcript for all private session testimony of W02749. On 4 April 2024, the Witness Protection and Support Office ('WPSO') sent its response agreeing with the SPO's redactions and proposing additional redactions to the testimony of W02749. On 15 April 2024, Victims' Counsel sent his response agreeing with the SPO's proposed redactions. The Defence teams did not send a response.

2. The SPO has consolidated all proposed redactions and related justifications in Annex 1.²
