Request for reclassification and related notice

1. As directed by the Single Judge,¹ the Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') requests to reclassify as 'Public' filings F00657 and F00664.²

2. Further, on 1 July 2024, the SPO filed a public redacted version of F00481. In light of the early stage of the proceedings - prior to the confirmation of an indictment - the applied redactions are necessary to, *inter alia*: (i) safeguard the integrity of ongoing investigations; (ii) maintain the confidentiality of investigative methods; and (iii) protect the privacy and/or security of named or otherwise identified persons.

¹ By email on 26 June 2024, the Court Management Unit conveyed the following instruction from the Single Judge: 'The SPO is instructed to indicate whether filings KSC-BC-2018-01/F00481, F00657, and F00664 can be reclassified as public, by no later than 1 July 2024. Should the SPO wish to retain the current classification of one or all the aforementioned filings, it shall: (i) specify the reasons for maintaining the current classification pursuant to Rule 82(3) of the Rules, and indicate whether and when such classification may be changed; and (ii) submit public redacted version(s) thereof, by no later than 1 July 2024.' The SPO responded by email on 1 July 2024. On 2 July 2024, the Single Judge instructed the SPO to 'submit its indications and/or requests formally on record through a filing [...] by Wednesday, 3 July 2024'.
