## I. INTRODUCTION

1. On 9 November 2023, the Panel granted, in part, a Motion<sup>1</sup> seeking admission of prior statements, and related associated exhibits, of the Accused.<sup>2</sup> On 26 September 2024, the Thaçi Defence alerted the SPO to a discrepancy in P00760, which had been admitted pursuant to the Decision. In light of that error, the SPO conducted a further review of relevant associated exhibits, and now requests the adjustments outlined below.

2. Pursuant to Articles 37 and 40 of the Law<sup>3</sup> and Rules 137 and 138 of the Rules,<sup>4</sup> the Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') requests the Panel to (i) link one item to an existing exhibit number; and (ii) admit into evidence four associated exhibits and their corresponding English translations.<sup>5</sup>

## II. SUBMISSIONS

### A. THAÇI JULY 2020 SPO INTERVIEW

3. P00760 comprises the associated exhibits from Hashim THAÇI's 13-17 July 2020 SPO Interview.<sup>6</sup> Page 076604 of P00760 erroneously does not reflect the page actually shown to THAÇI during that interview. It should contain p.SITF00243028, rather than p.SITF00243029.<sup>7</sup> However, given that both pp.SITF00243028 and SITF00243029 have anyway separately been admitted as P01749, the SPO requests, for the sake of accuracy and completeness, that P01749/P01749\_ET, p.SITF00243028 be

linked to P00760, and the comment field in Legal Workflow be updated to reflect the relevant procedural history.<sup>8</sup>

#### B. SELIMI NOVEMBER 2019 SPO INTERVIEW

4. Associated exhibits from SELIMI's 2019 SPO interview were erroneously not tendered in the Motion. The majority of these have been otherwise admitted.<sup>9</sup> For four of them, the SPO hereby requests their admission, together with their corresponding English translations.<sup>10</sup>

5. The four exhibits - which comprise a decision signed by SELIMI, two interviews given by him, and contemporaneous photographs – are relevant and probative. They form part of P00761 and should be admitted as they are used and discussed therein.<sup>11</sup>

#### III. RELIEF REQUESTED

6. For the foregoing reasons, the Panel should link one item to an existing exhibit number and admit into evidence four associated exhibits listed in Annex 1 to this supplement, in addition to the materials previously admitted.
