1. On 4 February 2025, Trial Panel I ('the Panel') issued its decision under Rule 94 of the Rules,¹ approving the plea agreements for all three Accused, and sentencing them to two and three years of imprisonment, with credit for time served.²
2. As regards reparations, the Panel ordered the Accused to pay the total sum of 500 Euros to Victim 1, divided between Mr. Haxhi Shala (400 Euros) and Mr. Sabit Januzi (100 Euros).³ The payments were ordered to be made by no later than Wednesday, 19 February 2025.⁴ The Registrar was ordered to report to the Panel by the same date on whether the sum has been paid to the designated bank account and to Victim 1.⁵
3. Pursuant to the Panel's order,⁶ the Registrar designated a bank account to receive the reparations, and informed Mr. Shala and Mr. Januzi of the required details to enable their payments.
4. The Registrar hereby informs the Panel that the funds from the two Accused have been received, in line with the Panel's order, on 6 and 11 February 2025 respectively. The total amount (500 Euros) has been transferred for Victim 1 on 17 February 2025.
