1. Pursuant to the Decision,¹ the Specialist Prosecutor's Office provides submissions on the classification of admitted material tendered in the Fifth Rule 155 Motion.²
2. The admitted evidence of witness W01473,³ with the exception of one associated exhibit which can be public,⁴ should remain confidential to give effect to W01473's protective measures. Similarly, the admitted evidence of witnesses W04431,⁵ W04648,⁶ and W04381⁷ should remain confidential to give effect to the witnesses' protective measures.
3. Further, W04252's admitted evidence⁸ should remain confidential due to the witness's evidence about victims of crimes whose identities are not public, and to give effect to existing protective measures. W04252 saw those victims in the detention centre and gives details about them.⁹
4. All remaining admitted materials can be classified as public.¹⁰


