Prosecution request for extension of time on preliminary motions responses

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- 1. Pursuant to Rules 9(5)(a), 76 and 97 of the Rules,¹ the Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') hereby requests an extension of time to file its responses to the Defence Preliminary Motions.² In particular, the SPO seeks leave to file, by Friday 30 May 2025: (i) its response to the Jurisdiction Motion;³ (ii) a consolidated response to the Severance Motions;⁴ and (iii) a consolidated response to the Indictment Defects Motions.⁵
- 2. There is good cause for the SPO's request. The SPO is required to respond to detailed submissions, presenting a range of complex and novel legal issues. Furthermore, noting the substantive overlap between the Severance Motions and considering that two Accused allege defects in the form of the Indictment, consolidated responses to those challenges are warranted to avoid duplicative and/or overlapping responses, and better focus the issues for judicial determination.
- 3. This request is filed sufficiently in advance of the expiration of the time limit, and as soon as practicable after due consideration was given to the Defence Preliminary Motions. The limited extension of time will not affect the expeditiousness of the proceedings, and no prejudice will be caused to the Defence. Granting this
