1. On 25 March 2024, the Single Judge issued the Decision on Victims' Counsel's Request to Set a Date for the Payment of Reparations and other Matters ('Decision'). ¹ In the Decision, the Single Judge ordered the Registrar to conduct an indigence assessment of Mr Salih Mustafa ('Mr Mustafa').²

- 2. On 10 October 2024, the Register filed a request with the Single Judge to issue orders for obtaining additional information and documentation from [REDACTED], which are required for the indigence assessment of Mr Mustafa.³
- 3. On 16 December 2024, the Single Judge issued a decision on the above request together with five orders to [REDACTED] for the purpose of the indigence assessment ('Decision of 16 December 2024').⁴ The Single Judge issued orders to the following [REDACTED]:
