**Notification of Fadil Fazliu's Transfer to Kosovo**

1. On 3 February 2026, the Single Trial Judge ordered Mr Fadil Fazliu's ('Mr Fazliu') provisional release from detention in Kosovo, subject to strict conditions ('Decision').<sup>1</sup> The Single Trial Judge also ordered the Registrar to make all practical arrangements regarding Mr Fazliu's release as expeditiously as possible.<sup>2</sup>
2. The Registrar hereby notifies the Single Trial Judge that Mr Fazliu was transferred to Kosovo on the morning of 10 February 2026. Mr Fazliu arrived in Kosovo at approximately 12:50 and was provisionally released from the custody of the Specialist Chambers ('SC') at approximately 13:40.
3. Mr Fazliu was provided with the necessary information related to the implementation of the conditions applicable to his release, including the local police station that will be managing his weekly reporting, and a designated SC contact person to whom he can convey, (i) for onward transmission, any requests to the Single Trial Judge for a change in residence and/or travel outside of Kosovo, and (ii) the address where he will reside while present on the territory of the Netherlands, for the purpose of attending court hearings.
4. The Registry also confirms the necessary arrangements to implement additional conditions ordered by the Single Trial Judge have been successfully made, and Mr Fazliu has been provided with the necessary information in this regard.<sup>3</sup>
5. The Registrar further confirms that, in accordance with the Single Trial Judge's Decision, the Registry has retained Mr Fazliu's passport and his national ID card. The Defence team for Mr Fazliu indicated to the Registry that these are the only travel documents Mr Fazliu has.<sup>4</sup>


