1. The Registrar hereby submits her final report pursuant to the “Decision on SPO Request for an Order (F00361) and Further Modalities for Independent Counsel Review” (‘Decision F00407’).¹

I. BACKGROUND

2. On 7 May 2025, the Pre-Trial Judge appointed [REDACTED] as Independent Counsel and tasked [REDACTED] with reviewing all of the material seized from Mr Hajredin Kuçi, namely: (i) [REDACTED], seized on 7 March 2024 (‘March Phone’); (ii) multiple (other) electronic devices, seized on 5 December 2024 (‘Kuçi Electronic Devices’); and (iii) a set of documents, also seized on 5 December 2024 (‘Kuçi Documents’).² The Pre-Trial Judge further: (i) adopted the modalities for the Independent Counsel’s review of the Kuçi Documents and certain content from the March Phone relating to witnesses of the Specialist Prosecutor’s Office (‘SPO’); and (ii) decided that the modalities for the review of the Kuçi Electronic Devices would be determined at a later stage.³

3. On 30 May 2025, the Pre-Trial Judge adopted the [REDACTED] Platform as a modality for the review of the Kuçi Electronic Devices and issued a request for assistance to the [REDACTED] (hereinafter referred to as ‘External Forensic Institute’ or ‘EFI’) to make the [REDACTED] Platform available to the Specialist Chambers.⁴ On 8 July 2025, the Pre-Trial Judge also instructed the Registrar to liaise with the EFI in order to facilitate Independent Counsel’s immediate access to training videos and/or materials concerning the [REDACTED] Platform.⁵

4. On 5 August 2025, the Pre-Trial Judge adopted the modalities for the Independent Counsel's review of the March Phone and the Kuçi Electronic Devices through the [REDACTED] Platform, with a view to identifying and excluding privileged information.⁶ The modalities also set out, *inter alia*, measures to be taken by the Registrar to facilitate the Independent Counsel's work.⁷ In addition, the Pre-Trial Judge set out reporting obligations for the Independent Counsel, the SPO and the Registrar, the latter being instructed to report on the execution of Independent Counsel's review within ten days of the filing of Independent's Counsel's final report.⁸ Specifically, the Registrar was instructed to include in her report details on the duration of the review, any issues encountered during the review process, and any precautionary measures adopted for the storage and protection of all review-related material.⁹

5. Finally, the Pre-Trial Judge also ordered the Registrar to: (i) continue to retain and preserve any material otherwise produced during the Independent Counsel's review until further instruction of the Pre-Trial Judge;¹⁰ (ii) liaise with the EFI and make all necessary arrangements for the Independent Counsel's access to the [REDACTED] Platform;¹¹ (iii) make various requests to the EFI, including for the upload of items to the [REDACTED] Platform and the provision of technical assistance to the Independent Counsel, as needed;¹² and (iv) keep the Pre-Trial Judge and Independent Counsel informed about the EFI's uploading progress, and request the EFI to preserve the material on the [REDACTED] Platform until at least the conclusion of the independent review process.¹³

II. REGISTRAR'S REPORT

6. The Registrar hereby reports on the execution of the Independent Counsel's review. In this regard, the Registrar has endeavoured to minimise the duplication of information already provided by the Independent Counsel in [REDACTED] final report,¹⁴ as well as duplication of the information already provided by the Registrar in her various interim reports relating to the Independent Counsel's review.¹⁵

7. At the outset, it is noted that the Registrar designated [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] as the two Registry focal points for communication, logistical and practical support to the Independent Counsel.¹⁶

A. PRELIMINARY PREPARATIONS PRIOR TO DECISION F00407

8. On 24 June 2025, as instructed,¹⁷ the Registrar informed the Pre-Trial Judge of Independent Counsel's availability to complete a limited assignment in the next three months.¹⁸

9. [REDACTED]. [REDACTED].¹⁹

10. Following the Pre-Trial Judge's adoption of the [REDACTED] Platform as a modality for the review of the Kuçi Electronic Devices,²⁰ the SPO communicated a list of items that should be given priority in being uploaded to the [REDACTED] Platform to the Registry focal points on 10 and 12 June 2025. Subsequently, on 12 June 2025, the Registry focal points communicated this list of priority items to the EFI.

11. From 9 July 2025, pursuant to the Pre-Trial Judge's instructions,²¹ the Registry focal points provided the Independent Counsel with information relevant to [REDACTED] familiarization with the [REDACTED] Platform. This included information provided by the EFI via the Registry focal points, such as hyperlinks to training materials and arrangements for access to the demonstration and learning platforms.

12. On 1 August 2025, the Registrar informed the Pre-Trial Judge of the completion of the legal and contractual process necessary for the use of the [REDACTED] Platform.²²

B. PREPARATIONS PURSUANT TO DECISION F00407

13. On 5 August 2025, the Registry focal points securely transferred an electronic copy of Decision F00407 to the Independent Counsel.

14. On 6 August 2025, the Independent Counsel informed the Registry focal points that, in light of [REDACTED], [REDACTED] would be available to commence working from 23 August 2025 at 50% capacity, as previously confirmed,²³ cognizant of the need to expeditiously complete [REDACTED] assigned tasks.

15. Later that same day, the necessary contractual formalities concerning Independent Counsel's appointment were completed by the Registry, as instructed by the Pre-Trial Judge in her 7 May 2025 decision appointing Independent Counsel.²⁴ Immediately thereafter, the Registry focal points securely transmitted to the Independent Counsel electronic copies of the documents set out in paragraph 46(e) of Decision F00407.²⁵

16. On 7 August 2025, pursuant to paragraphs 56-58 and footnote 76 of Decision F00407, the Registry focal points communicated with the EFI regarding facilitating the Independent Counsel's access to the [REDACTED] Platform as of 23 August 2025, in line with [REDACTED] earliest availability, as well as uploading items to the [REDACTED] Platform, including in accordance with the SPO's prioritisation. The EFI was also asked to provide periodic updates on the progress of its work, including progress in uploading items to the [REDACTED] Platform, and to preserve the material on the [REDACTED] Platform until at least the conclusion of the independent review process. The EFI confirmed that same day that the materials included in the SPO's priority list had already been uploaded.

17. On 12 August 2025, the SPO communicated to the Registry focal points changes to its priority list, which were then communicated to the EFI.

18. On 18 August 2025, the Registry focal points securely transferred to the Independent Counsel electronic copies of Decision F00284 and certain filings pursuant to paragraph 37(b) of Decision F00284, as instructed by the Pre-Trial Judge.

19. Concurrently with the preparatory steps outlined above, the Registry focal points also liaised with [REDACTED] to facilitate the provision of translation/interpretation assistance to Independent Counsel, as needed. The Registry focal points also made other logistical preparations, such as: (i) preparing a room at the Specialist Chambers' premises as the designated location for the Independent Counsel's activities, including the provision of a safe for the secure storage of materials; (ii) securing the assistance of [REDACTED] to install at the designated location a designated stand-alone desktop computer for use by the Independent Counsel pursuant to Decision F00407; (iii) securing the assistance of [REDACTED] and the EFI to configure the designated computer to ensure that it has secure access to the [REDACTED] Platform, [REDACTED].

20. On 18 August 2025, the Registry focal points liaised with Independent Counsel to clarify some further details regarding [REDACTED] access to the designated location and the designated computer, necessary materials, the [REDACTED] Platform, and translation/interpretation assistance.

21. On 19 August 2025, pursuant to footnote 57 of Decision F00407, the SPO provided the Registry focal points with [REDACTED] certain materials to be provided to Independent Counsel. The relevant transfer document was completed.²⁶

22. On 21 August 2025, the EFI confirmed to the Registry focal points that the Independent Counsel had been provided with access credentials for the [REDACTED] Platform.

C. REVIEW BY THE INDEPENDENT COUNSEL

23. On 25 August 2025, the Independent Counsel started [REDACTED] review work pursuant to Decision F00407. Specifically, Independent Counsel met at 9:00 with a Registry focal point who assisted [REDACTED] with the initial set-up, including by providing [REDACTED] with [REDACTED], the [REDACTED] provided to the Registry on 19 August 2025, and [REDACTED] documents relevant to [REDACTED] work.²⁷ In addition, [REDACTED] assisted Independent Counsel with setting up [REDACTED] the designated computer. The Registry focal points and an interpreter remained available to Independent Counsel, as needed. Later that same day, [REDACTED] also provided Independent Counsel with [REDACTED] a video tutorial for the [REDACTED] Platform, for [REDACTED] reference.

24. On 2 September 2025, following Independent Counsel being tasked to work on other matters in the designated location,²⁸ [REDACTED] temporarily paused [REDACTED] work pursuant to Decision F00407 and the designated computer was disconnected [REDACTED] pending resumption of [REDACTED] review activities.²⁹

25. On 5 September 2025, at the Pre-Trial Judge's email request, the Independent Counsel indicated that [REDACTED] level of availability for October and November 2025 would remain the same, namely at 50% capacity.³⁰

26. After resuming [REDACTED] work pursuant to Decision F00407, Independent Counsel again paused [REDACTED] work pursuant to Decision F00407 between 9 and 13 October 2025, due to being tasked to work on other matters in the present case.³¹

27. [REDACTED],³² [REDACTED]³³ [REDACTED]³⁴ [REDACTED]. [REDACTED].

28. On 14 October 2025, Independent Counsel further updated the Pre-Trial Judge on [REDACTED] availability for October and November 2025, noting that [REDACTED] would be unavailable between 22 October and 2 November 2025.³⁵

29. On 17 October 2025, the Registry focal points alerted Independent Counsel [REDACTED] to a since-corrected typographical error in a filing made by the Registrar,³⁶ [REDACTED].³⁷

30. On 21 October 2025, Independent Counsel informed the Pre-Trial Judge, via the Registry focal points, that, due to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] review work would need to be paused until 25 November 2025.³⁸

31. On 12 November 2025, the Pre-Trial Judge informed Independent Counsel, via the Registry focal points, that [REDACTED] intended to transfer the case file to a Trial Panel.³⁹

32. On 17 November 2025, the Registry focal points provided the Independent Counsel with a copy of the President's decision assigning a Single Trial Judge.⁴⁰

34. On 27 November 2025, Independent Counsel sought, via the Registry focal points, the Single Trial Judge's guidance regarding the export of raw data pursuant to Order F00538.⁴¹ On 5 December 2025, the Single Trial Judge provided the requested guidance,⁴² which the Independent Counsel subsequently followed.

35. On 3 December 2025, the Independent Counsel reported to the Registry focal points [REDACTED]. This was addressed that same day by [REDACTED], and Independent Counsel was able to resume [REDACTED] work.

36. In January and February 2026, Independent Counsel met several times with EFI staff to resolve technical issues that the Independent Counsel was encountering with the [REDACTED] Platform, as detailed in Section G, below.

38. On 5 March 2026, the Registry focal points provided Independent Counsel with a copy of the Single Trial Judge's oral order setting a 13 March 2026 deadline for the Independent Counsel's final report pursuant to Decision F00407.⁴³ Independent Counsel informed the Registry focal points that [REDACTED] anticipated filing [REDACTED] final report on 10 March 2026. As detailed below, a Registry focal point met with Independent Counsel on 9 and 10 March 2026 to execute the process of preserving the designated computer and materials produced during the Independent Counsel's work, pursuant to paragraph 46(u) of Decision F00407.

39. On 10 March 2026, with the assistance of [REDACTED], the Independent Counsel handed over to the Registry focal points a USB device containing [REDACTED] final report, for filing in Legal Workflow. The report was filed that same day.⁴⁴ Thereafter, the designated computer was shut down and disconnected, and

subsequently preserved, as detailed in Section I, below. The designated location was then checked and the Independent Counsel handed over to the Registry focal points [REDACTED]. Thereafter, Independent Counsel left the Specialist Chambers' premises.

40. During Independent Counsel's review activities, the Registry focal points also provided Independent Counsel with logistical assistance around the clock, including during weekends and evenings. In addition, each time that the Independent Counsel submitted a filing or was instructed to transfer materials to the SPO via the Registry, the Registry focal points and [REDACTED] provided assistance, including with regard to computer settings, compliance with instructions and the formal requirements for filings, and ensuring that the filings and materials were processed promptly.

47. In addition to the matters already discussed earlier in this report, [REDACTED] also assisted the Independent Counsel with issues concerning [REDACTED], and providing [REDACTED] with [REDACTED].

F. SUPPORT FROM [REDACTED]

48. [REDACTED] provided interpretation/translation assistance to the Independent Counsel, as needed, including during weekends, as coordinated through the Registry focal points. In addition to [REDACTED].⁴⁸

G. SUPPORT FROM THE EFI

49. On 18 August 2025, the Registry focal points informed the EFI of the re-prioritisation in the uploading of items to the [REDACTED] Platform, following the receipt of information from the SPO pursuant to Decision F00407. On 21 August 2025, the EFI confirmed that the prioritised items had been uploaded to the [REDACTED] Platform.

50. On 27 August 2025, Independent Counsel met [REDACTED] with EFI staff to ask questions about the [REDACTED] Platform.

51. On 22 September 2025, the Registry focal points arranged a meeting between Independent Counsel and EFI staff, [REDACTED]. At the Independent Counsel's request, the Pre-Trial Judge had varied paragraph 46(o) of Decision F00407, for the purposes of facilitating this meeting.⁴⁹ A copy of the Pre-Trial Judge's variation decision was securely transferred to Independent Counsel on 22 September 2025, and a Registry focal point met with Independent Counsel at the designated location that same day to receive [REDACTED] materials that Independent Counsel wished to have printed in order to take with [REDACTED] to the meeting with EFI staff. The Registry

focal point printed the materials and provided them, together with [REDACTED], to Independent Counsel.

52. On 2 October 2025, the EFI informed the Registry focal points that [REDACTED]. The Registry focal points duly informed Independent Counsel that same day.

53. On 13 October 2025, Independent Counsel requested an [REDACTED] meeting with EFI staff in relation to a technical matter concerning the [REDACTED] Platform. The meeting was duly arranged and took place on 15 October 2025.

54. A meeting was also arranged [REDACTED] on 22 January 2026 between Independent Counsel and EFI staff to review certain technical issues [REDACTED]. The Single Trial Judge was kept informed of the meeting throughout the planning stages.⁵⁰ Following further investigation by the EFI, another follow-up [REDACTED] meeting was held between the EFI staff and Independent Counsel on 3 February 2026, as well as a meeting [REDACTED] on 9 February 2026. Pursuant to a decision by the Single Trial Judge, Independent Counsel was able to take relevant notes with [REDACTED] for the 9 February 2026 meeting.⁵¹

H. REGULAR UPDATES TO THE PRE-TRIAL JUDGE AND SINGLE TRIAL JUDGE

55. Pursuant to paragraph 46(f) of Decision F00407, the Registry focal points kept the Pre-Trial Judge and thereafter the Single Trial Judge regularly informed of the Independent Counsel's activities, including: (i) technical matters raised by the Independent Counsel; (ii) the Registry focal points' liaising with the EFI on the Independent Counsel's reporting of issues; and (iii) updates on the Independent Counsel's progress and the assistance provided to [REDACTED] by the Registry.

I. PRESERVATION OF ITEMS IN THE VAULT

56. Pursuant to paragraph 46(u) of Decision F00407, the designated computer, notes taken by the Independent Counsel, and any other material produced during the review process have been preserved in the [REDACTED] Vault.

57. Specifically, on 9 and 10 March 2026, a Registry focal point met Independent Counsel at the designated location for several hours to execute the process of preserving the items. The relevant chain of custody documents were completed.⁵²

58. These materials remain safely and securely stored in the Vault. [REDACTED]. [REDACTED]. [REDACTED].

J. THE [REDACTED] PLATFORM

59. Pursuant to paragraph 46(m) of Decision F00407, Independent Counsel's access to the [REDACTED] Platform was terminated following the submission of [REDACTED] final report. Specifically, once the designated computer was disconnected and preserved in the Vault on 10 March 2026, Independent Counsel was no longer able to access the [REDACTED] Platform, [REDACTED]. In addition, on 11 March 2026, the Registry focal points informed the EFI that Independent Counsel's access to the [REDACTED] Platform needed to be terminated. On 12 March 2026, the EFI confirmed that the permissions for Independent Counsel's account on the [REDACTED] Platform had been retracted and that the relevant support team within the EFI had been informed to no longer exchange information with Independent Counsel.

60. Pursuant to paragraph 58 of Decision F00407, the Registrar notes that the potential use of the [REDACTED] Platform remains available to the Specialist Chambers, and all of the items that have been uploaded to the [REDACTED] Platform remain preserved thereon, until 30 April 2026.
