THE PRE-TRIAL JUDGE, pursuant to Article 39(3) of Law No. 05/L-053 on

Specialist Chambers and Specialist Prosecutor's Office and Article 36(1) of the

Practice Direction on Files and Filings ("Practice Direction"), hereby issues the

following decision.

I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

1. On 25 April 2020, the Specialist Prosecutor submitted for confirmation a strictly

confidential and ex parte indictment ("Indictment") together with evidentiary

material supporting the material facts underpinning the charges and a detailed

outline demonstrating the relevance of each item of evidentiary material to each

allegation.2

2. On 22 May 2020, the Specialist Prosecutor requested, pursuant to Article 36(1) of

the Practice Direction,³ an extension of word limit up to 9,000 words, in order to

make meaningful submissions on the request for the arrest and transfer of the

suspects referred to in the Indictment and associated reliefs ("Request").4

II. APPLICABLE LAW

3. Pursuant to Article 41 of the Practice Direction, any motion shall not exceed

6,000 words.

4. Pursuant to Article 36(1) of the Practice Direction, participants to proceedings

may seek, sufficiently in advance, an extension of the word limit upon showing

that good cause exists constituting exceptional circumstances.

III. DISCUSSION

5. The Specialist Prosecutor intends to make multiple submissions regarding the

arrest and transfer of the four suspects referred to in the Indictment, search and

seizure, [REDACTED], and non-disclosure of the Indictment and related

material.⁵

6. The Pre-Trial Judge considers that the request for extension of word limit has

been filed sufficiently in advance in the present circumstances as there is no

deadline for filing the requests foreshadowed by the Specialist Prosecutor in the

Indictment.

7. With regard to the good cause requirement, taking into account the number of

submissions to be made, the complexity of the issues at stake and related need to

set out in sufficient detail the facts, arguments and evidence underpinning said

submissions, as well as the number of suspects to which those submissions

relate, the Pre-Trial Judge finds that in the present case good cause exists,

constituting exceptional circumstances, to justify the requested extension of

word limit. Accordingly, the Request is granted.
