I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registrar hereby reports to the Pre-Trial Judge on the execution of the order for transfer of Mr Pjetër Shala ('Mr Shala') to the Detention Facilities of the Specialist Chambers ('Detention Facilities') located in the Netherlands ('Host State').¹

II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

- 2. On 12 June 2020, the Pre-Trial Judge issued a decision² confirming charges against Mr Shala for war crimes punishable under Articles 14(1)(c) and 16(1)(a) of the Law on Specialist Chambers and Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('Law')³.
- 3. On 12 June 2020, the Pre-Trial Judge also issued a decision granting a request by the Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') for an arrest warrant and transfer order ('Decision on Arrest and Transfer').⁴ In the Decision on Arrest and Transfer, the Pre-Trial Judge directed the Registrar, in consultation with the SPO, to transmit the arrest warrant and transfer order to the competent authorities of the Kingdom of Belgium, or any other Third State, as the case may be, for service and execution.⁵
- 4. On 30 July 2020, the Registrar requested the cooperation of the competent Belgian authorities in the arrest of Mr Shala and his transfer to the detention facilities of the Specialist Chambers in the Host State.⁶
- 5. On 16 March 2021, the Registrar notified the Pre-Trial Judge that Mr Shala was arrested in the Kingdom of Belgium by the Belgian Police, in the presence of representatives of the SPO.⁷

III. INTERIM REPORT ON TRANSFER

6. On 16 March 2021, following his arrest, Mr Shala formally filed an appeal

pursuant to Article 86(1) of the Belgian Law on Cooperation.8 The Chamber has fifteen

days from the date the appeal is lodged to render its decision. This means that the

Chamber has until 31 March 2021 to render its decision. No appeal in cassation may

be lodged against the decision of the Chamber on the appeal.¹⁰

7. Following the decision on the appeal, the Registrar will make the necessary

arrangements for the prompt transfer of Mr Shala to the Detention Facilities, in

accordance with the Decision on Arrest and Transfer. 11 The Registrar will notify the

Pre-Trial Judge and inform the relevant parties and persons promptly upon Mr Shala's

reception at the Detention Facilities.¹² Pursuant to the Decision on Arrest and

Transfer, 13 the Registrar will also submit a report on the arrest and the transfer of Mr

Shala to the Pre-Trial Judge before the initial appearance.
