I. INTRODUCTION

1. On 25 September 2020, the Pre-Trial Judge requested the Registrar to submit her reasons for maintaining the classification of certain filings in case file KSC-BC-2020-05 or to submit confidential (redacted) and/or public (redacted) versions thereof ('Order').¹ Pursuant to the Order and Rule 82 of the Rules², the Registrar hereby provides submissions on the reclassification of filings in case file KSC-BC-2020-05.

2. This submission is filed as strictly confidential and *ex parte* in accordance with Rule 82(4).

II. SUBMISSIONS

A. RECLASSIFICATION: PUBLIC

- 3. The Registrar submits that she has no objection to the reclassification, as public, of the following filings:
 - a. F00013, Registrar, "Notification of Arrest Pursuant to Rule 55(4)" ('F00013');
 - b. F00014, Registrar, "Notification of Reception in the Detention Facilities of the Specialist Chambers" ('F00014').
- 4. Pursuant to Article 39 of the Practice Direction on Files and Filings,³ changes to the classification of F00013 and F00014 may be implemented by the Court Management Unit ('CMU') upon judicial authorisation.
- 5. Accordingly, pursuant to the Order, the Registrar respectfully requests the Pre-Trial Judge to authorise CMU to implement the changes to the classification of F00013 and F00014 from strictly confidential and *ex parte* to public.

- a. F00014/A01, Registrar, "Annex 1 to Notification of Reception in the Detention Facilities of the Specialist Chambers".
- 7. The purpose of the limited redaction to F00014/A01 is solely to remove the identifying information of a Registry staff member.
- 8. Pursuant to the Order, the Registrar also informs the Pre-Trial Judge that she has submitted a public, redacted version of the following filing:
 - a. F00015, Registrar, "Submission of the Registrar Pursuant to Rule 23(2) on COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Measures" ('F00015').
- 9. The redactions to F00015 are necessary [REDACTED]; [REDACTED], [REDACTED]. [REDACTED]. [REDACTED]. [REDACTED]. Public disclosure of the above-mentioned information would be detrimental to the Registrar's exercise of her functions, including the detention function.⁵

C. RETAIN CLASSIFICATION: CONFIDENTIAL

- 10. Finally, the Registrar submits that the following filing should remain confidential:
 - a. F00015/A01, Registrar, "Annex 1 to Submission of the Registrar Pursuant to 23(2) on COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Measures" ('F00015/A01').
- 11. Retaining the classification of F00015/A01 is necessary at this time [REDACTED]. [REDACTED].⁶ Public disclosure of F00015/A01 would be detrimental to the Registrar's exercise of her functions, including the detention function.⁷
