Prosecution request for extension of word limit on responses to preliminary motions

1. The Defence has filed two preliminary motions pursuant to Rule 97,<sup>1</sup> for which the Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO')'s responses are due on 6 September 2021.<sup>2</sup> In respect of each response, the SPO requests an extension of the word limit pursuant to Article 36(1) of the Practice Direction.<sup>3</sup>

2. Each motion filed by the Defence is close to the word limit.<sup>4</sup> In some instances, the Defence has 'endorsed' the submissions of Defence teams in other cases before the KSC.<sup>5</sup> These endorsements and references, combined with the lengthy challenges including to JCE as a mode of liability alleged in both motions,<sup>6</sup> require detailed and lengthy submissions in response by the SPO.

3. In light of the foregoing, there is good cause for an extension of the word limit for the response to the Jurisdiction Challenge to 15,000 words and for a modest extension for the response to the Indictment Challenge to 12,000 words.<sup>7</sup> No prejudice would be caused to the Defence by doing so, noting that, pursuant to Rule 76, the Defence will have the opportunity to reply to any new issues raised in the SPO's responses.
