TRIAL PANEL I (Panel) hereby renders this decision on motion for extension of time limit for submissions on expert reports.

I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

- 1. On 3 September 2021, the Panel issued the "Third decision on the appointment of experts", appointing three individuals as experts in the present case (Appointed Experts), instructing them to report on certain topics identified by the Panel by 22 November 2021, and instructing the Defence for Salih Mustafa (Defence) and Victims' Counsel to make submissions on the report, if they so wish, within two weeks of its notification.¹
- 2. On 19 November 2021, upon request by the Victims' Participation Office² and Victims' Counsel,³ the Panel extended the time limit for the submission of the experts' report(s) to 17 December 2021 and the time limit for any Defence and Victims' Counsel submissions thereon to 21 January 2022.⁴
- 3. On 17 December 2021, the Registrar transmitted⁵ the Appointed Experts' respective reports (Reports).⁶

4. On 14 January 2022, the Registrar transmitted the English translation of one of the

Reports.7

5. On 20 January 2022, Victims' Counsel submitted a request for extension of the

time limit to make submissions on the Reports to 25 January 2022 (Request).8

II. SUBMISSIONS

6. Victims' Counsel submits that the fact that the English translation of one of the

Reports was only transmitted to Victims' Counsel on 14 January 2022, outside of

working hours, constitutes good cause for an extension of the time limit to

25 January 2022 to file her submissions on the Reports. Victims' Counsel further avers

that, not only was she left with only five working days between the transmission of

the aforementioned translation and the deadline for submissions, but within this

five-day period, court hearings, which she attended, were held over two days, leaving

her with insufficient time to prepare her submissions which require an analysis of the

key findings of the Reports, including a comparative analysis thereof. 10

III. APPLICABLE LAW

7. The Panel notes Article 40(2) of Law No. 05/L-053 on Specialist Chambers and

Specialist Prosecutor's Office and Rule 9(5) and (6) of the Rules of Procedure and

Evidence Before the Kosovo Specialist Chambers (Rules).

IV. ANALYSIS

8. At the outset, the Panel notes that the Request was filed only one day before

the expiry of the relevant time limit. In this respect, the Panel notes that, in the

future, the Parties and Victims' Counsel shall endeavour to file requests under

Rule 9(5) of the Rules sufficiently in advance of the expiry of the time limit at issue.

9. Having considered the reasons put forward by Victims' Counsel, in particular

the fact that the translation of one of the Reports was only made available to her

one week before the deadline for submissions, outside of working hours, and the

fact that the preparation of the submissions on the Reports requires, inter alia, a

comparative analysis thereof, the Panel finds that good cause has been

demonstrated, warranting the requested extension of time. Furthermore, noting

that the reasons for providing the requested extension to Victims' Counsel equally

apply to the Defence, should it wish to make submissions on the Reports, the Panel

also extends the time limit for any Defence submissions on the Reports to

25 January 2022.

10. Considering that the requested extension will cause no delay in the

proceedings and noting that the Defence is granted the same extension of the time

limit to make submissions on the Reports, if it so wishes, no prejudice is caused to

the Defence in issuing the present decision prior to receiving its response to the

Request, in accordance with Rule 9(6) of the Rules.

V. DISPOSITION

11. For the above-mentioned reasons, the Panel hereby:

a. **GRANTS** the Request; and

b. INSTRUCTS the Defence and Victims' Counsel to make submissions on

the Reports, if they so wish, by **Tuesday**, **25 January 2022**.
