1. Pursuant to the Order,¹ the Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') hereby presents its views on whether the timelines indicated in the Second Decision² should be maintained.

2. Noting the limited scope of the Preparation Conference,³ and that the Defence made no request for suspension of the timelines in question in its Notice,⁴ the SPO considers that proceedings should continue in accordance with the schedule indicated in the Second Decision, without prejudice to the determination of any request pursuant to Rule 130.⁵

3. Proceedings under Rule 130 and those envisaged in the Second Decision should run in parallel, as suggested in the Order.⁶ This course of action will cause no prejudice to the Accused, and will best ensure the expeditiousness of the proceedings as mandated by Article 40(2) of the Law.⁷
