I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. Pursuant to the Trial Panel's Decision on the Conduct of Proceedings,¹ and Rule 138(1) of the Rules,² and in compliance with the Panel's oral order of 28 March 2022,³ the SPO hereby requests the admission into evidence of the items listed in Annex 1 to this Request ('Documents'). The Documents include portions of prior statements made by Defence Witnesses 200, 300 and 500, and referred to by the SPO during cross-examinations of the witnesses, as well as material shown to Defence witnesses 200, 300, 400 and 500.
- 2. The Documents are relevant, authentic, have probative value, and their admission would cause no undue prejudice to the Accused.⁴
- 3. Pursuant to Rule 82(3), Annex 1 to this Request is filed as confidential in order to protect confidential information in this case.

II. SUBMISSIONS

a. **Prior statements**

4. The parts of the prior statements and transcripts that were used with the Defence Witnesses during cross-examination are tendered into evidence.⁵ In some cases,⁶ larger portions than those strictly used are tendered into evidence in order to give a fair context to the questions and answers, and in light of comments made by the

witnesses.⁷ Where an Albanian translation was not available,⁸ the SPO has requested translation of the relevant excerpts and will upload them in LWF as soon as ready.

5. The interview of the Accused with the SPO,⁹ as well as other documents or photographs used with the Defence witnesses in cross-examination but already in evidence ¹⁰ are not tendered again.

b. Documents and photographs

6. The miscellaneous documents and photographs¹¹ used with the Defence witnesses during cross-examination are self-explanatory, and are tendered in their entirety, as they are limited in length and scope.

c. Open-source materials

7. The open-source materials that were used with the Defence Witnesses during cross-examination¹² are tendered into the record only for the purposes of a credibility assessment of the witnesses.

III. RELIEF REQUESTED

8. For the foregoing reasons, the SPO requests admission of the documents used during the cross-examinations of Defence Witnesses 200, 300, 400 and 500, as listed in confidential Annex 1 to this Request.
