1. The Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') does not oppose a reasonable variation of the time limit for certification to appeal the Decision.¹ However, the Joint Defence Request² to essentially triple the time period set out in Rule 77 of the Rules³ is excessive. The Defence does not substantiate why they require this extraordinary amount of time to file their request for leave to appeal or why a shorter extension is not sufficient. The SPO defers to the Pre-Trial Judge as to the appropriate extension.
