1. On 27 July 2022, the Defence for Mr Shala ("Defence") requested an extension

of time to file any submissions in response to the Prosecution observations on

the continued detention of the Accused at any time deemed appropriate after

the Defence Pre-Trial Brief is filed on 5 September 2022.1

2. In support of this request, the Defence refers the Pre-Trial Judge to the

statement by the Accused which is set out in the Annex to the present

submission.

3. The statement confirms that the Accused waives his right pursuant to Article

41 of the Law No. 05/L-053 on Specialist Chambers and Specialist Prosecutor's

Office to have the lawfulness of his continued detention reviewed before the

22nd of August 2022 and for a period of 5 weeks.

4. The statement by the Accused is without prejudice to any of his rights under

the KSC Law, the Kosovo Constitution, and the European Convention on

Human Rights.

5. The Accused reiterates his position that he is willing to abide by any condition

allowing his provisional release that may be deemed appropriate and that his

continued detention is not strictly necessary or proportionate and in breach of

his fundamental rights.
