The Defence for Mr Pjetër Shala (“Defence” and “Accused”, respectively) hereby notifies the Pre-Trial Judge of its intention to object to the admissibility of evidentiary material that has been disclosed on the basis of Rule 102 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence before the Kosovo Specialist Chambers (“Rules”), pursuant to Rule 95(2)(e) of the Rules and as ordered by the Pre-Trial Judge on 14 April 2022.¹
2. The Defence notifies the Pre-Trial Judge of its intention to challenge the admissibility of the evidentiary material identified in the strictly confidential Annex to this Notice pursuant to Rule 138(1) and Rule 138(2) of the Rules.
3. This Notice is filed to facilitate the conduct of the pre-trial proceedings as requested by the Pre-Trial Judge and without prejudice to the right of the Accused to object to the admissibility of any item disclosed under Rule 102 of the Rules or tendered for admission into evidence by the Prosecution at trial.


