1. Pursuant to the Order on the Conduct of Proceedings,¹ the Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') hereby submits a supplemental notice under Rule 102(3) of the Rules ('April 2023 Notice').²

2. The April 2023 Notice lists two items falling under Rule 102(3) which have been recently obtained and, although in need of further processing and review,³ are being promptly noticed, separately, now by way of this filing. The SPO has taken steps to ensure they can be disclosed expeditiously should the Defence request them.

3. As previously submitted, the SPO will continue to discharge its obligations under Rule 102(3), including as additional items falling within the scope of the rule are obtained or cleared.⁴ In that respect, any other recently obtained items falling within Rule 102(3) will be included in an additional notice to be filed in due course.

4. The April 2023 Notice is confidential in accordance with Rule 82(4), to give effect to applicable confidentiality restrictions and protective measures, and for the protection and privacy of the individuals identified therein.
