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- 1. Pursuant to the Conduct of Proceedings Order,<sup>1</sup> the Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') submits Annex 1, listing additional witnesses for the 4-13 December 2023 evidentiary block.<sup>2</sup>
- 2. To fulfil the SPO's obligations under paragraph 81 of the Conduct of Proceedings Order, and considering developments in the proceedings and/or the unavailability of certain, previously notified witnesses,<sup>3</sup> it was necessary to identify further witnesses for the December 2023 evidentiary block.<sup>4</sup>
- 3. In reaching these discretionary scheduling decisions,<sup>5</sup> the SPO has taken into account and balanced a number of (often competing) factors, including: (i) publicity; (ii) witness availability, testimony modes, examination estimates, and sitting schedules; (iii) the scope, nature, and subject matter of the witness's anticipated testimony; (iv) the status of the presentation of evidence; (v) the witness's personal circumstances; (vi) security concerns; and (vii) the need to provide adequate notice.
- 4. As required by the Conduct of Proceedings Order, Annex 1 sets out the following as to the witnesses: (i) name and pseudonym; (ii) all prior statements; (iii) the mode of testimony; (iv) the issues, facts, and circumstances in relation to which the witness will be examined; (v) time estimate for direct examination; (vi) documents which the SPO intends to use with each witness (identified by their complete ERN,6 the date, description and relevance of each document, and the exhibit or MFI number
