Duty Counsel for Isni Kilaj Iain Edwards 1. In the Continued Detention Reasons,¹ the Single Judge set a schedule for the filing of submissions for further review of Kilaj's detention. In the event the Defence did not file submissions by 5 December 2023, the SPO was ordered to file submissions by 11 December 2023. The Defence filed its submissions on 7 December 2023, and requested a retroactive extension of the time limit for doing so.² The Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') hereby notifies the Single Judge that, in the interest of efficiency and pursuant to *inter partes* agreement, it intends to file one consolidated submission within the timeline set out in Rule 76 to respond to the Defence Submissions,³ rather than also making a separate filing on 11 December 2023, and simultaneously will not object to the Defence Submissions on the basis of timeliness.⁴

2. This filing is submitted as confidential in accordance with Rule 82(4), but the SPO does not object to its reclassification as public.
