1. Pursuant to Article 23 of the Law¹ and Rule 80(1) of the Rules², the Registry's Witness Protection and Support Office ('WPSO') hereby transmits to Trial Panel II a

request for protective measures made by witness [REDACTED] during his

preparation and court familiarisation in advance of his scheduled testimony on

[REDACTED] 2023.

2. On [REDACTED] 2023, pursuant to the Registry's internal regulations on

services to witnesses appearing before the Specialist Chambers ('SC'),3 WPSO

conducted a pre-testimony security interview with witness [REDACTED], prior to his

courtroom familiarisation.

3. During this pre-testimony security interview, the witness indicated that he does

not have fears for his personal safety, and is keen to testify in public. However, he did

raise a concern around [REDACTED], who according to the witness began

[REDACTED]. According to the witness, the [REDACTED] is located in [REDACTED]

and while the witness is not concerned about [REDACTED] safety directly,

[REDACTED] nonetheless raised concerns about [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is

concerned that if he testifies in public without any protective measures, [REDACTED].

4. In support of the above, [REDACTED] gave the following additional

explanations:

5. [REDACTED] was informed about the role, rights and obligation of witnesses in

the proceedings, including the right to request protective measures. Having received

explanations about protective measures subject to a decision by the Panel, the witness

stated that he remained willing and eager to testify publicly, but that he would like to

request limited protective measures in the form of a pseudonym and non-disclosure

to the public of any records identifying the witness [REDACTED], for the reasons

stated above.

6. If the witness's request is granted, WPSO recommends that the Panel also order

non-disclosure to the public of the [REDACTED].

7. [REDACTED],⁴ [REDACTED]. However, the specific circumstances giving rise

to the witness's concerns [REDACTED] had not yet materialized at that time.⁵

8. Pursuant to Rule 82(3) of the Rules, this submission is filed as strictly confidential

and *ex parte*, as it contains sensitive information related to the witness. A confidential

redacted version will be filed shortly.
