1. Pursuant to the Order<sup>1</sup> and as foreshadowed,<sup>2</sup> the Specialist Prosecutor's Office ('SPO') hereby tenders the audio-video recordings of witness statements previously admitted pursuant to Rule 153 of the Rules.<sup>3</sup> These audio-video recordings are listed in Annex 1,<sup>4</sup> with the corresponding witness codes, ERNs and exhibit numbers of admitted statements, disclosure packages, and admission decisions.<sup>5</sup>

2. Consistent with the Order, the SPO will tender any audio-video recordings of proposed statements as part of future motions under Rules 143(2)(c),<sup>6</sup> 153, and 155.<sup>7</sup>

3. Annex 1 is confidential to give effect to existing protective measures.<sup>8</sup>
