We got the additional prep note in the form of an addendum, and the ERN for that is 120935. That addendum does not explain why the witness wanted to review that exhibit. Today, I therefore asked the witness why he wanted to see the exhibit, and he said at page 65, lines 17 to 18:

"I did not ask. They showed it to me."

There is an apparent conflict here between what the witness is saying and what the Prosecution informed us as to what transpired.

My only point is that had we had an audio recording of this preparation session, we wouldn't be in this difficult position of not being able to resolve a conflict without calling upon the
