6	JUDGE GUILLOU: Good afternoon, everyone. And welcome inside
7	and outside the courtroom.
8	Before we start, in my decision to set the date for this Initial
9	Appearance, I had anticipated some pictures by a photographer, but I
10	think, counsel, that you have some reservations with picture of your
11	client. Is that the case?
12	MR. SYTEMA: Yes, Your Honour. I have advised my client not to
13	have his picture taken. Is it
14	JUDGE GUILLOU: Yes, it works.
15	MR. SYTEMA: Your Honour, I've advised my client not to have his
16	picture taken. He is not a publicly known figure, and I guess his
17	privacy is endangered too much by his photo wandering around the
18	internet in connection with this case. So I think his privacy should
19	be considered in this matter.
20	JUDGE GUILLOU: Counsel, would you agree if we were to take
21	group settings; i.e., not a close-up on your client? Because this
22	hearing is broadcasted on the internet anyway, because we have
23	publicity of proceedings. But we have pictures of the whole
24	courtroom and not a specific close-up on your client. Would this be
25	agreeable to you?

MR. SYTEMA: That would be agreeable. Thank you. 1

- JUDGE GUILLOU: Thank you, counsel.
- I will ask the photographers to make pictures of the courtroom
- itself and no close-ups on the accused, please. You have one minute
- and a half. 5
- Thank you, Madam Photographer. You may now leave the courtroom. 6
- 7 Madam Court Officer, can you please call the case.
- THE COURT OFFICER: Your Honour, this is file KSC-BC-2023-10, 8
- The Specialist Prosecutor versus Sabit Januzi and Ismet Bahtjari. 9
- JUDGE GUILLOU: Thank you, Madam Court Officer. 10
- Before asking those present in the courtroom to introduce 11
- 12 themselves, I would like to remind everyone of a few rules that must
- be observed at all times in order to make courtroom proceedings 13
- 14 smooth.
- Please make sure that you activate your microphone before 15
- speaking and that you switch it off as soon as you're finished. 16
- slowly and clearly as we have interpretation from and into Albanian 17
- 18 and Serbian. And wait five seconds before responding to me or a
- party or participant in order to allow the interpreters to finish the 19
- interpretation. 20
- What is said in this hearing is transcribed in realtime and will 21
- be reflected in a transcript available to the parties and to the 22
- public after this hearing. 23
- I would also like to remind the parties that certain information 24
- 25 in this case is subject to protective measures and confidentiality

- 10 JUDGE GUILLOU: What is your citizenship or what are your
- 11 citizenships?
- 12 THE ACCUSED BAHTJARI: [Interpretation] Albanian.
- JUDGE GUILLOU: What is your current profession?
- THE ACCUSED BAHTJARI: [Interpretation] I am a builder. I am an
- 15 electrician.
- JUDGE GUILLOU: Thank you, Mr. Bahtjari. You may be seated.
- 17 Let me now move to the procedural history of the case.
- On 2 October 2023, in my capacity as Pre-Trial Judge, I
- confirmed the indictment submitted by the Specialist Prosecutor
- against Mr. Bahtjari charging him with the offences of: Count 1,
- 21 attempt to construct official persons in performing official duties
- by serious threats; Count 2, attempt to obstruct official persons in
- performing official duties by participating in the common action of a
- group; and Count 3, intimidation during criminal proceedings.
- On 5 October 2023, the SPO arrested Mr. Bahtjari in Kosovo, at

- which point he was served with the Confirmed Indictment. 1
- Mr. Bahtjari was transferred to the detention facilities of the 2
- Kosovo Specialist Chambers in The Hague on 6 October 2023.
- Mr. Bahtjari, before we proceed any further, I have to make sure

- and speak. Can you confirm that you understand and speak Albanian? 6
- THE ACCUSED BAHTJARI: [Interpretation] I confirm. I do confirm. 7
- JUDGE GUILLOU: Thank you, Mr. Bahtjari. By this, I am 8
- satisfied that you can follow the proceedings in Albanian, a language 9
- that you understand and speak, in accordance with Rule 92 of the 10
- Rules of Procedure and Evidence. 11
- If at any moment you do not understand or you are not receiving 12
- interpretation, please draw my attention to it immediately. 13
- 14 THE ACCUSED BAHTJARI: [Interpretation] It's all fine. I shall
- do so. 15
- JUDGE GUILLOU: Thank you. 16
- Now, let me explain the specific purpose of the Initial 17
- 18 Appearance for the benefit of the accused and those joining us in the
- public gallery and to follow the proceedings online. 19
- Today's hearing is not a trial. No evidence will be presented 20
- or debated. And the guilt or innocence of the accused will not be 21
- discussed or decided. The purpose of this Initial Appearance is 22
- regulated by Article 39 of the Law and Rule 92 of the rules. 23
- According to these provisions, I shall have the charges in the 24
- Confirmed Indictment read to the accused in a language he understands 25

- Should either party wish to discuss any other matter not 11

- 14 First, Mr. Bahtjari, may I ask you to confirm that you received
- the Confirmed Indictment in a language that you understand and speak? 15
- THE ACCUSED BAHTJARI: [Interpretation] Yes, I do confirm. 16
- JUDGE GUILLOU: Thank you, Mr. Bahtjari. 17
- I will now ask Madam Court Officer to read out the charges in 18
- the Confirmed Indictment as foreseen in Article 39 of the Law and 19
- Rule 92. 20
- THE COURT OFFICER: Thank you, Your Honour. 21
- In the Confirmed Indictment, the Specialist Prosecutor charges 22
- Mr. Ismet Bahtjari with: 23
- Count 1: Attempting to obstruct official persons in performing 24
- official duties by serious threat punishable under Article 401(1) and 25

- 1 (5) of the 2019 Kosovo Criminal Code and Article 15(2) of the Law;
- Count 2: Attempting to obstruct official persons in performing
- official duties by participating in the common action of a group
- 4 punishable under Article 401(2) and (5) of the 2019 Kosovo Criminal
- 5 Code and Article 15(2) of the Law;
- And Count 3: Intimidation during criminal proceedings
- 7 punishable under Article 387 of the 2019 Kosovo Criminal Code and
- 8 Article 15(2) of the Law;
- 9 2. These offences were committed between at least 5 and
- 10 12 April 2023.
- 3. In relation to these offences, there is a well-grounded
- suspicion that Mr. Ismet Bahtjari is criminally responsible pursuant
- to Article 16(3) of the Law for:
- 14 (a) committing the offence under Count 3, pursuant to Article 17
- of the 2019 Kosovo Criminal Code;
- 16 (b) co-perpetrating with Mr. Sabit Januzi the offences under
- 17 Counts 1 to 3, pursuant to Article 31 of the 2019 Kosovo Criminal
- 18 Code;
- 19 (c) assisting in the commission of the offences under Counts 1
- to 3, pursuant to Article 33 of the 2019 Kosovo Criminal Code;
- 21 (d) agreeing to commit with Mr. Sabit Januzi the offences under
- 22 Counts 1 to 3, pursuant to Article 35 of the 2019 Kosovo Criminal
- 23 Code; and/or
- (e) attempting to committing the offences under Counts 1 to 2,
- pursuant to Article 28 of the 2019 Kosovo Criminal Code.

Mr. Bahtjari, I wish to remind you that it is not time to

contest the charges but simply to acknowledge your understanding of

the charges. You will have ample opportunity to challenge the

charges with the assistance of your counsel. 6

7 Mr. Bahtjari, did you understand the charges contained in the

Confirmed Indictment as read by Madam Court Officer?

THE ACCUSED BAHTJARI: [Interpretation] Yes. 9

JUDGE GUILLOU: Thank you, Mr. Bahtjari. You may be seated. 10

Now, let me inform you about your rights before this Court. 11

The Law on the Specialist Chambers and the Rules of Procedure 12

and Evidence guarantee you a number of rights, and I will read out

the most important ones.

First, you shall be presumed innocent until proven quilty beyond 15

reasonable doubt. In the determination of the charges against you, 16

you are entitled to a fair and public hearing, subject to any 17

18 measures ordered for the protection of victims and witnesses.

You have the right to be informed promptly and in detail in a 19

language which you understand of the nature and the cause of the

charges against you. 21

You have the right to adequate time and facilities for the 22

preparation of your defence and to communicate with the counsel of

your own choosing. 24

You have the right to be tried within a reasonable time. 25

You have the right to be tried in the presence of your counsel 1 and in your presence.

- You have the right to have counsel assigned to you and without 3 payment if you do not have sufficient means to pay for it. 4
- You have the right to examine or have examined the witnesses 5 against you and to obtain the attendance and examination of witnesses 6 7 on your behalf.
- You have the right to have the free assistance of an interpreter 8 if you cannot understand or speak the language used in the Court. 9
- You have the right not to be compelled to testify against 10 yourself or to admit guilt. 11
- You have the right to remain silent, and no adverse inference 12 shall be drawn from your silence. 13
- 14 You also have the right to make unsworn statements relevant to the case, and you may appear as a witness under oath. 15
- You have the right to lodge preliminary motions to challenge the 16 jurisdiction of the Specialist Chambers, to allege defects in the 17 form of the indictment, and to seek the severance of the indictment. 18
- You have the right to receive, within 30 days of today's 19 hearing, the supporting material to the indictment submitted for 20 confirmation. 21
- You have the right to receive all statements of witnesses whom 22 the Specialist Prosecutor intends to call to testify at trial in the 23 language you understand and speak, namely, Albanian. 24
- You have the right to receive immediately any information which 25

may reasonably suggest your innocence or mitigate your quilt, or 1

- affect the credibility or the reliability of the
- Specialist Prosecutor's evidence, as soon as the information is in
- his custody, control, or actual knowledge.
- You have the right that all material and relevant evidence or 5
- facts in possession of the Specialist Prosecutor be made available to 6
- you before the beginning of and during the proceedings. This right 7
- is only subject to restrictions which are strictly necessary and when 8
- any counterbalancing protections are applied. 9
- You have the right not to be detained for an unreasonable period 10
- prior to the opening of the case, to request review of decisions on 11
- your detention, and to appeal such decisions directly before the 12
- Court of Appeal. 13
- 14 You have the right to appeal directly before the Court of Appeal
- a decision on preliminary motion challenging the jurisdiction of the 15
- Specialist Chambers, and you have the right to seek leave to appeal 16
- other decisions. 17
- 18 Mr. Bahtjari, you have heard the most important rights that you
- enjoy in accordance with the applicable legal framework of the 19
- Specialist Chambers. Do you understand these rights, Mr. Bahtjari? 20
- THE ACCUSED BAHTJARI: [Interpretation] Yes, I do understand. 21
- JUDGE GUILLOU: Thank you, Mr. Bahtjari. You may be seated. 22
- I wish to inform that, according to Article 21(5) of the Law, 23
- you may not represent yourself because you are currently in 24
- detention. Representation by a Specialist Counsel is, therefore, 25

- mandatory. It is my duty, as Pre-Trial Judge, to ensure that your 1
